

Booster Club Individual Points Requirements

Booster Club Individual Duty Introduction:

Anna FFA Booster Club (named AFBC for remainder of the article) is Anna FFA's local promotional group. Their duties are to assist in all FFA functions but primarily raise money for the support of Anna FFA member's SAE (Supervised Agriculture Experience) projects, namely market and breeding cattle, swine, lambs, goats, rabbits, chickens, horticulture and Ag mechanics projects.

Activity/Points Outline

All Anna FFA members and families are expected to participate in the booster club if they expect the AFBC to support their animal at the Collin County Livestock Show. Participation and points allotment is described in the chart below.

Activity Description	Points Acquired from Activity
<p><u>Assistance at AFBC concession stands</u></p> <p>Students and/or parents can assist with the booster club concession stand. Working a game is described as assisting in 1 time slot. The time slots are to be signed up for prior to the game. It is the student's responsibility to check in with their ag teacher upon arrival for work and departure from work.</p>	<p>2 points per timeslot. Close family members can assist to allow a student to gain points as well. Students can work multiple time slots per game.</p>
<p><u>AFBC auction donations</u></p> <p>All Anna FFA members participating in the booster club is REQUIRED to provide a minimum of 2 auction items. An auction item is defined as an item that possess a 20\$ value or higher. Value of items will be evaluated by agriculture science teachers. If a student does not provide 2 auction items, they will not be allowed to obtain any funds from the booster club.</p> <p>Additional items with a 20\$ value will allow a student to obtain 1 additional point per item.</p>	<p>2 points from the mandatory items PLUS 1 point per additional item.</p>
<p><u>Totals:</u></p>	<p>If a student fully participates in all activities outlines above, no more than 10 points can be obtained.</p>

AFBC Point Policy

AFBC can provide financial assistance at the Collin County Jr. Livestock Show Auction (CCJLS) and/or as a personal donation to an individual SAE participate. AFBC executive board members make the final decision on all financial assistance offered.

Financial assistance will be based on points obtained. 1 pt will allow the SAE participate 10% of the total monies allotted for the specific species/sex/project type exhibited. A student can obtain no more than 100% of the monies allotted. The chart below will outline the percentage of allotted money that will be obtained in accordance to the points obtained:
